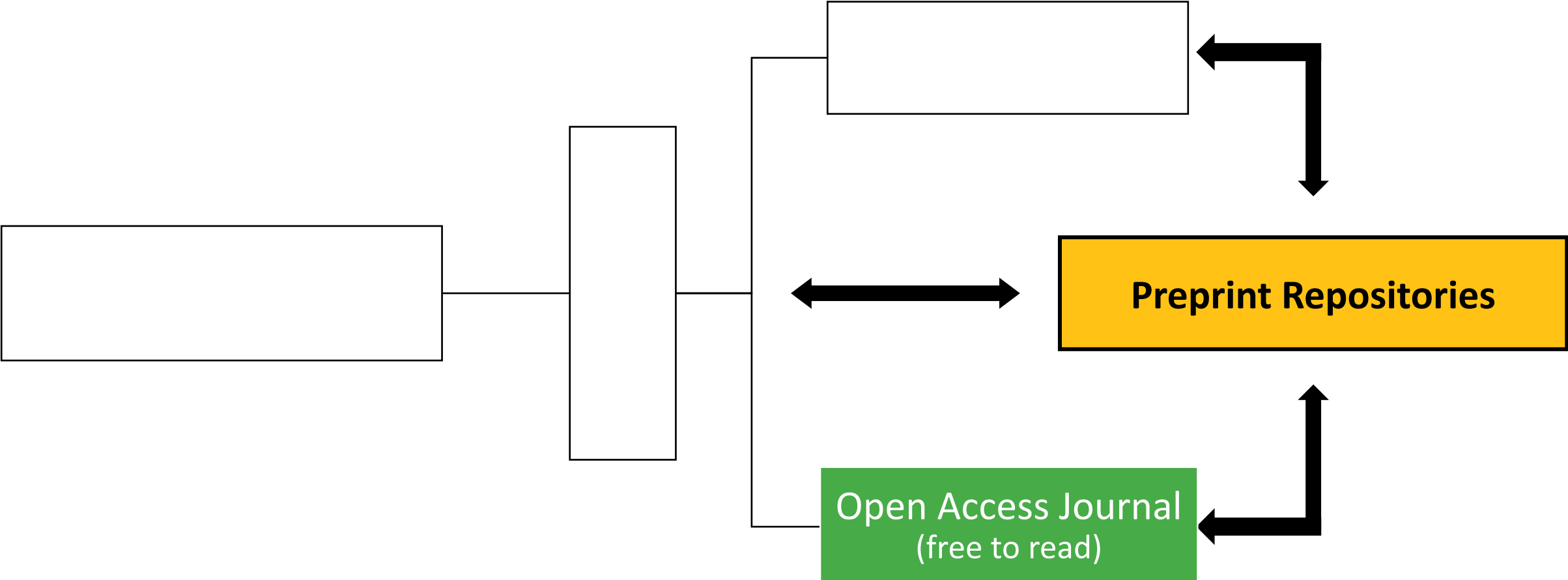

## Preprint Repositories

Freely accessible online digital archive which enable you to post an early version of your research paper online (preprint or postprint)

**Preprint** is usually a full draft of a research paper that is shared publicly before formal peer review and publication in a scientific peer-reviewed journal. (DOI)

**Postprint** is a draft of a research journal article after it has been peer reviewed and accepted for publication, but before it has been typeset and formatted by the journal. (DOI)

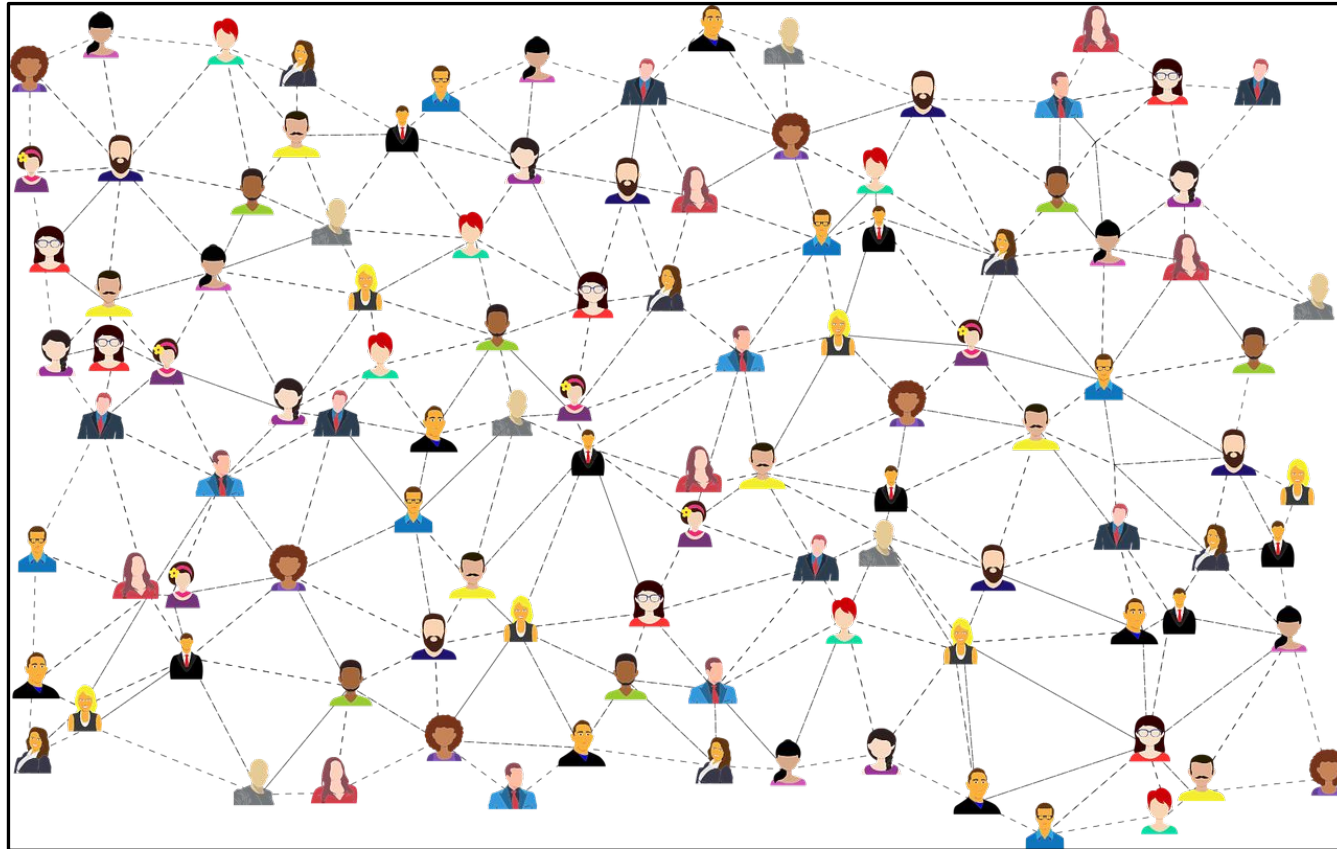

## Visibility

Preprint repositories are open access which mean more people will access, read and cite your research paper

## Quick Release
